<Lights up on the sixth floor of the Math building. A large door is set on stage. Les and Cy (Jay and Silent Bob-like characters) are standing near it. Reid (the narrator) enters carrying a book.>

- 1 **Reid:** Once upon a time, in a math building far, far away, a group of students were wandering on the sixth floor searching for their TA's office. *<Alison enters>* There was Alison, the hard working, likable student. *<Moe enters>* Moe, the outgoing one. *<Laurent enters>* Laurent who was shy and reserved. *<Dyna enters>* And Dyna, the very smart one. Also there were Les and Cy, two non-math students who somehow ended up being lost on the sixth floor.
- 2 **Les:** I don't get it, Cy. Where are all the honeys? I thought you knew where we were going.
- *<Cy points at the students.>*
- 3 **Les:** Ah, there they are.
- 4 **Fassworth:** < from off-stage > I hear voices. Is someone there?
- <*Enter Dean Fassworth>*
- 5 **Reid:** And in walked Professor Fassworth, the Dean of Math. He had been Dean for many years.
- 6 **Fassworth:** Students?!? What are you doing here?

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7 - **Alison:** We're looking for our TA's office. I desperately need help for my next assignment.

8 - **Fassworth:** Excellent! Always good to see students looking for help from someone other than me. *<To Les and Cy>* You two don't look like math students.

<Les and Cy shake their heads "No">

9 - **Fassworth:** Why are you here?

<Les and Cy huddle and discuss.>

- 10 Les: Me and my heterosexual life-mate are scouting for some action.
- 11 **Fassworth:** *<laughing>* Preposterous! No one looks for action in the math building.

<Thurman, Eugene and Phyllis enter. Thurman is carrying a rope.>

- 12 **Reid:** In time, they were joined by the rest of their friends: Eugene the engineer, Thurman the physics student and Phyllis the philosophy student, or so she thought. They had set out to help their mathie friends find the TA's office.
- 13 **Thurman:** Hey guys, we couldn't find the office either.
- 14 **Eugene:** Maybe I should go look for some more help.
- 15 **Phyllis:** As Confucious said, "why design a building such that its occupants become so easily lost?"
- 16 **Dyna:** Confucious never said that! I don't even know why I came along. I've already finished this assignment and the next one, too. I could be in the comfy lounge doing something better with my time.
- 17 All: Like what?
- 18 **Dyna:** Uh.... well, you know. Settlers?
- 19 **Fassworth:** Why do all the students have something against the sixth floor? Everything is so straightforward and clearly marked! There's nothing wrong with it. I'll go find you a map.

< Exit Fassworth. >

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20 - **Reid:** As Fassworth went to a find a map for these helpless students, a ghost suddenly appeared.

<Will appears.>

- 21 **Reid:** The ghost brought a message of warning.
- 22 **Will:** If Waterloo be your home, far away never roam.

Danger comes, on the sixth floor. Hear my message, avoid the door. Just like me, you'll meet your doom. Stay away from this TA's room.

<Will disappears. Enter Fassworth>

- 23 **Fassworth:** Oh where did that map of mine go? < *looks at students*> What's the matter? Looks like you've all seen a ghost.
- 24 **Moe:** I think we just did, Dean.
- 25 **Reid:** Fassworth explained to the students that the Math building could not possibly be haunted. That would mean someone died there some time ago. *<Fassworth does a nervous laugh>* Alison asked the Dean where the TA's office was located. Laurent pointed to the large door, but Fassworth said that the TA wouldn't be in there. He explained that the door led to a lounge for faculty and grad students only...
- 26 Fassworth: ... and worthless undergrad students such as yourselves should stay out!

< Fassworth exits>

- 27 Les: If that's a lounge, there's got to be a vending machine in there. I could really use some munchies.
- 28 **Laurent:** But you heard the Dean. We're not allowed in there.
- 29 **Dyna:** Look, it doesn't hurt to knock, does it? Just open it up and take a peek inside. Hey, what's the worst that can happen?
- <Dyna slowly opens the door. Bright light shines out from the behind the door.>
- 30 **Reid:** Indeed. What was the worst that could happen?

<Lights down.>

<Lights up on the three students passed out on the ground in an Oz (yet Waterloo)-like setting. A large "Columbia Street" sign is on stage. Laurent is snoring. Enter Fender (Oz Tin-man, Futurama Bender) drunk and stumbling slightly. Enter Dallas (Oz Scarecrow wearing a flock of seagulls haircut) followed by Harry (Oz Lion) and Ruby (Oz Dorothy).>

- 1 **Dallas:** They're after me!!!
- 2 **Ruby:** < out of breath > For the last time, there are no birds after you! And there is no way a flock of seagulls could fit in a pie!
- 3 **Dallas:** Not seagulls, crows! Crows are after me! They'll peck my straw out! And I've run so far away! I can't get away! < sobs>
- 4 **Harry:** *<sneezes>* Wait just a gosh darn minute. Aren't you a scarecrow? Aren't you supposed to scare birds away?
- 5 **Dallas:** Shut up! Shut up! <*cries*> I'm such a failure!
- 6 **Fender:** Man, you need to get over those birds. < takes a big swig from a bottle > Oh yeah, that's the stuff.
- < Fender trips over Laurent and falls flat on his face>

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7 - **Fender:** Ah crap. Maybe I shouldn't have finished off that keg. Alright, someone help me up!

- <Dallas and Ruby help Fender up while Harry examines Laurent>
- 8 **Harry:** Now what have we here? I see your problem. You're falling down because you tripped over the biggest and deadest Munchkin I've ever seen! They must swell up after they die...
- 9 **Ruby:** He's not a Munchkin, he looks like a student. And he's not dead, genius. He wouldn't be snoring if he was dead. <*shakes Laurent awake>* Hey, you okay?
- 10 **Laurent:** What happened to Alison? *<rushes over to Alison>* Ah, my beauty, are you okay?
- < Laurent wakes up Alison as Ruby walks over, wakes up Moe and helps him up.>
- 11 **Moe:** *<noticing Ruby>* Hey there, baby. How are... *<looking around>* Wait a second. It doesn't look like I'm in math anymore. Where am I?
- 12 **Harry:** In the merry old land of Waterloo!
- <Harry does a little dance (ends with a sneezing fit) as Ruby, Fender and Dallas groan and look embarrassed>
- 13 Laurent: What?
- 14 **Fender:** He said you're in Waterloo, dumbass! *<belches>*
- 15 Harry: We're on a journey to find the Wizard of Waterloo!
- 16 **Alison:** Why do you want to find the Wizard?
- 17 **Fender:** Why? Why? That's a good question. Why are we?
- 18 **Harry:** I'm hoping the Wizard can help me with my allergies. *<sneezes>*
- 19 **Alison:** What are you allergic to?
- 20 **Harry:** Fur. Keeps making me sneeze. < sneezes>
- 21 **Dallas:** I'm hoping the Wizard can make the birds go away. Every where I go see them. *<pointing to the sky>* There they are again!
- < Dallas hides behind Harry.>

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22 - **Fender:** As for me, I have no need to see the Wizard. I'm perfectly normal. <*Ruby smacks him upside the head.*> Except that I drink too much.

- 23 **Ruby:** I'm hoping the Wizard can get me back home. I've been lost here for quite a awhile.
- 24 **Alison:** It appears you and I have something in common. I don't recognize any of this. Where's the university plaza? The high school down the street? The math building?
- 25 **Ruby:** The math building? You mean, you're from UW too?
- 26 **Moe:** Yeah, how did you wait, what do you mean, too?
- <Screaming peasants/villagers run across the stage carrying children and belongings and other assorted props. This should continue gradually throughout the rest of the scene. Among them should be the members of the Village People. As many crazy costumes, props and signs as possible. Hans, Flo, and Connie stop. Connie should not be wearing glasses.>
- 27 Hans: It's after us!
- 28 **Flo:** Run for your lives!
- 29 **Connie:** < *looks back and shakes fist towards offstage* > A plague on both your houses!
- 30 **Hans:** Both?
- 31 Connie: Yeah, both of them!
- 32 Flo: You forgot your glasses again, didn't you?
- 33 **Moe:** What's going on? Who's after you?
- 34 **Hans:** Not who, what! A dragon! A terrible, terrible dragon! With pointy teeth and consummate V's!
- <Enter Tammy, Layon (always speaks in a Scottish accent) and Goldie, with more peasants, screaming, crying and wailing.>
- 35 **Tammy:** He's burninating the villages!
- 36 **Alison:** Burninating? Is that a real word?
- 37 **Dallas:** Buh buh burninating? Does that involve fire?

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- 38 **Layon:** Aye laddie, a LOT!
- <Dallas curls into the fetal position crying and sucking his thumb, whispering "fire", "burninating", "straw, lovely straw" as he fixes his hair, "crows", "seagulls" over and over again randomly>
- 39 Layon: He's burned down our thatched roof cottages! Everything's gone!
- 40 **Tammy:** And he's been stomping on all the village people! We've lost half the village!
- 41 Goldie: And all my porridge!
- *<They all stop and look at her>*
- 42 Goldie: My beautiful, wonderful porridge! It's gone! All gone!
- 43 **Harry:** I'm sure you can get some more somewhere –
- 44 **Goldie:** <angry and crazy-obsessive> No! You don't understand! It took me weeks to perfect it! First, it was too hot, then too cold, and finally I got it JUST RIGHT when <sobs> I'll never get that recipe right again!
- <Goldie cries and runs off stage>
- 45 **Fender:** Wow, what a wack job. *<belches, then kicks Dallas>* Oh get up you wuss.
- <Dallas gradually gets to his feet>
- 46 **Fender:** You're dry enough that you'll burn up real quick. I'll bet you won't feel a thing. < laughs>
- 47 Harry: Leave him alone, the boy's terrified of fire and I don't blame him!
- 48 **Fender:** Really? And I suppose you're all set to fight the dragon and save everyone, huh, mister King-of-the-forest?
- 49 **Harry:** Well, now, uh, let's not be hasty... *<sneezes>*
- 50 **Ruby:** Oh for Pete's sake. < aside, exasperated > Men... < to villagers > Is everyone all right? Did you all get out okay?
- 51 Hans: I think we all got out alive. But our entire village is gone!
- 52 **Layon:** He even destroyed my collection of the finest 100 proof scotch-whiskey.

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- 53 **Fender:** < falling to his knees> NOOOOOO! < bangs head on stage>
- 54 **Connie:** Running for your life while screaming, mind you is thirsty business. Do you have anything to drink?
- 55 **Harry:** He does. *<points at Fender, who smacks him in the back of the head>* Uh, I mean, no.
- 56 **Ruby:** Nothing you'd want to drink, anyway.
- 57 **Layon:** Ack, I say we all head to the Drunken Fairy Tavern. They never let the taps run dry! *<shouts>* Who's with me?
- 58 **Moe:** So how do we get to this tavern?
- 59 Layon: If we follow Columbia Street, we can't miss it.
- 60 **Alison:** Follow Columbia Street?
- 61 **Laurent:** Follow Columbia Street?
- 62 **Flo:** Follow Columbia Street.
- 63 **Fender:** So I guess we're going to Philip Street?

< Ruby smacks Fender in back of the head. >

<Lights up on the King's castle. Two thrones are set up in the middle of the stage for the King and Queen. Les and Cy are hiding behind the thrones. Edward is standing around as Al enters.>

- 1 **Al:** Good morning, Edward. Have you seen what's happening out there? Displaced people, buildings on fire, women and children running for their lives, cats and dogs living together, mass hysteria everywhere! It's crazy!
- 2 **Edward:** Just another typical morning in Waterloo, Al. But things wouldn't be that way if I were in charge!

<*Enter Cindy>*

- 3 Al: Oh, little sister, thank goodness you're all right!
- 4 **Cindy:** Morning brothers.
- 5 **Al:** Another late night?
- 6 Cindy: Yes. I was searching high and low for my knight in shining armour...
- 7 **Edward:** And live happily ever after?

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- 8 **Cindy:** That's what I wish for every day.
- 9 **Edward:** < laughing > That's crazy talk!
- 10 **Cindy:** Why, just last night, some guy tried to pick me up. Suggested we go up the hill and fetch a pail of water.
- 11 Al: Is that what the kids are calling it these days?
- 12 **Cindy:** Thing is, he really did want to fetch a pail of water. Even brought his own bucket. But he had a little too much at the tavern and fell all the way down the hill. Busted himself up pretty bad. We spent most of the night in the hospital. That's a date I'd like to forget.
- 13 Al: You never have the greatest of luck, do you?
- 14 **Cindy:** I just want to have a date for the ball. Is that too much to ask?
- <*Enter Eve and Anne>*
- 15 **Eve:** Check this out. We got these invitations in our mailbox.
- 16 Anne: We've been selected to go on a date with Prince Charming.
- 17 **Cindy:** Let me see that.
- *<Cindy grabs invitation from Eve and quickly scans it.>*

- <*Eve and Anne laugh>*

- < Eve and Anne exit. Cindy exhibits a stunned and angered look. >
- 21 Cindy: Excuse me, boys. I have some things to clear up.
- <Cindy exits. Enter Queen.>
- 22 **Queen:** < grumpy> Morning.

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23 - Al: I trust you slept well last night.
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24 - Queen: No. Your father was up late and then snored the rest of the night.

25 - **Edward:** Up late preparing for today's business?

26 - Queen: No! He was partying it up all night. Bastard.

<Queen sits on her throne.>

27 - Al: Well that was unexpected.

<*Enter Roy.*>

28 - **Roy:** Your attention! The king approaches!

<*Enter King>*

- 40 **Edward:** There was no proof he was ever behind that.
- 41 **Al:** Well, I hear things...
- *<The King rejoins the group>*
- 42 **King:** Damn Wizsters! I guess we'll have to send in our army. That shouldn't be a hard job for them.
- 43 **Edward:** Father, your army is in total disarray. We had to fire the last guy after he couldn't win any battles. $\langle to Al \rangle$ Who did we lose to?

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- 44 Al: Gryphons, Marauders, Yeomen. Our Warriors just couldn't beat any of them.
- 45 **Edward:** So we had consultants search for a tough knight to lead us to victory. <*to offstage>* Roy! Get me Inne! Show me De Monnet!
- <Enter De Monnet and Inne>
- 46 **De Monnet:** Good day, your majesties.
- 47 **King:** Have you brought me a replacement to lead my army?
- 48 **De Monnet:** Oh yes, sir. He's best in all the land.
- 49 Inne: A very brave chap who, legend has it, once took out seven with one blow.
- 50 **King:** Seven dragons with one blow, eh?
- 51 **De Monnet:** < pause, hesitates > Uh, yeah! You'll love him sir! He has excellent knight vision!
- 52 **Inne:** Here comes the man of the hour now.
- < Enter Lance surrounded by the Maidens: Betty, Dawn and Jill>

- 59 **Al:** But can you save us from this dragon? Can you be the brave savior who can defend the region with all his might?
- 60 Lance: Most definitely.

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- 73 Lance: Did anyone get the number of that truck?
- 74- Al: Edward, see if you can find something for his head.
- < Edward exits. Les and Cy come out from behind thrones. >
- 75 **Les:** Whoa dude, did you see that Queen chick? She's lookin' fine and could use some loving.
- *<Cy points out that the King could easily kill Les.>*
- 76 Les: What? I could easily take that king dude in a fight.
- <Cy shrugs.>
- 77 Les: So you recognize any of this?
- *<Cy shakes head in disagreement.>*

- 45 **Edward:** < to King > I will now give you an additional minute to think about my request. And I will continue to have my back turned to the entrance as I await your answer.
- <As royalty continues to discuss, Matt, Alison, Laurent, Moe and Ruby rush in and knock down Edward, all six fall to the floor.>

- 57 **Edward:** This can't be happening! I'm supposed to be king! < As being dragged off stage by Virginia and Peter> All hail King Edward!

- <*Les and Cy exit.*>
- 67 **Moe:** < wearing Lance's helmet > Hey, look at me! I'm a knight.
- <Enter maidens. Moe turns around and sees them. All maiden lines are said very seductively.>
- 68 **Dawn:** There you are, Lance. We wondered what happened to you. We have been anxiously awaiting your return.
- 69 **Moe:** But I'm...
- 70 **Betty:** You told us to wait in the castle, and I've been anxiously waiting to model my new French maiden outfit for you...
